Description

How to install RACHEL on a laptop or PC running the Raspbian O/S

JamesK has created the Raspbian local installer.

1. Install Raspbian from <https://www.raspberrypi.org/downloads/> Make sure you choose to download the Raspbian Desktop for PC or Mac.
2. Open a terminal and run the following commands
3. `sudo apt-get update`
4. `sudo apt-get upgrade`
5. `sudo reboot now` (to reboot the system)
6. Download [raspbian_x86_local_12_03_2019.zip](#)
7. Unzip it and place the installer directory in the /var/tmp directory
8. Open a terminal and run the following commands
9. `cd /var/tmp/installer`
10. `sudo python3 installer.py`
11. When the installation completes run “sudo reboot now” to reboot the system

That should be it. When you reboot you should be able to access RACHEL at <http://rachel> or <http://www.rachel.com>. If you click the admin interface you should be able to log in and install modules if you're connected to the internet. The admin username is Admin with the password Rachel+1

Note: Should the first run through of installer.py fail on net-tools then instal them manually with **sudo apt-get install net-tools**
Then re-run `sudo python installer.py` This time the whole process should run without a hitch.

TechNote: The file to download is at http://rachelfriends.org/downloads/public_ftp/rachelpi_64EN/rachelpi_2019/raspbian_x86_local_12_03_2019.zip (All on one line)
If you use WinSCP to download it the host is <ftp.worldpossible.org> with the username anonymous and the password anonymous.
